Addresses Vandalism, Remains Focused on Issues

(Thiensville) Over the Independence Day weekend coordinated acts of vandalism and destruction of Alberta Darling campaign signs took place along Lake Drive in Milwaukee County. Senator Darling issued the following statement:

“I am disappointed to see that a group of dissenters will go so far as to trespass, vandalize and steal campaign signs from the yards of Darling supporters. Wisconsin voters should not behave in this manner. My hope is that these acts are unrelated and the work of pranksters, but my fear is that these are outside interests attempting to intimidate voters and silence their opinion.

“I am proud of my record of standing up for hard-working families, and remain focused on the issues important to voters in the 8th senate district and the taxpayers of Wisconsin.”

Darling added that because of multiple calls to the police department and complaints received at the campaign offices, the campaign intends to work with proper authorities to ensure that this type of behavior is discouraged and ends immediately.

Supporters who have had their yard signs vandalized or stolen are encouraged to stop in the Glendale office at 311 W. Silver Spring Drive or call 414-727-4445 for a new yard sign.

State Senator Alberta Darling has been representing the 8th Senate District, which covers the 22nd, 23rd, and 24th assembly districts, since 1992. She currently serves as Co-Chair of the Joint Finance Committee, and chairs the Senate Committee on Finance.
