Darling Campaign Releases Statement

SANDY PASCH MUST COME CLEAN ON COORDINATION

(Thiensville) - On Monday, the Republican Party of Wisconsin filed a complaint with the Government Accountability Board asking for an investigation into possible coordination between Sandy Pasch and Citizen Action Wisconsin. Pasch serves as a board member for the group, and her campaign treasurer, Jackie Boynton, is also the treasurer for Citizen Action Wisconsin. Coordination between third party groups and candidates is illegal.

The Campaign Manager for Senator Alberta Darling's race, Andrew Davis, issued the following statement:

“As we have seen throughout the campaign from Sandy Pasch, she has little regard for right and wrong. Coordinating with third party groups is a very serious matter and the Darling campaign hopes that the Government Accountability Board looks into this immediately. Sandy is willing to blatantly and repeatedly lie about Medicare cuts. She's received a 'Pants on Fire' from the Journal Sentinel's Politifact for saying Alberta wants to end health care for seniors. Now we uncover the fact that there is possibly illegal coordination occurring. It's going to be rather difficult for Sandy Pasch to plead ignorance when she sits on the board of directors for Citizen Action Wisconsin, and her campaign treasurer is also managing the finances for that same third party group.

It's time for Sandy Pasch to come clean to the voters of the 8th District about her role in coordinating these false attacks against Alberta Darling. When did Sandy know about the attacks and when will she call on them to stop?

Until she comes clean, it's up to the people of the 8th Senate District to decide if this is the kind of person they want representing them. Alberta Darling has always been there for the taxpayers of Wisconsin. She's stood up to the special interests that are pulling Sandy's strings. The special interest groups are counting on Sandy Pasch, the people of the 8th Senate District already know they can count on Alberta Darling.”
